## AGM

## Speed Limit

Despite a 30mph speed limit in all villages being government policy there has been no progress in this matter so the speed limit in the village stays at 60mph and, legally, anyone parking a vehicle without lights on the roads in the village during the hours of darkness is liable to prosecution. Any further communication on this matter should be addressed to either the Parish Council or the County Council.
