Cold calling is when an uninvited tradesperson calls at your home and tries to sell you a product or service. Although some of the tradespeople are legitimate, some unfortunately are not, and prey on the elderly and vulnerable. All too often a doorstep seller can be checking things out with a view to returning and carrying out a burglary. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council with the help of the police and Neighbourhood Watch can setup No Cold Calling Zones but this requires the support of all the residents.
