Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on 23 November 2018

The Barn Dance was again a success thanks to the hard work of the committee and many local people. The income generated has kept the hall warm and fully insured. We have also given it a new look by redecorating and placing blinds at the windows. We have since discovered rot in the roof timbers. This has been repaired but the Gents toilet will have to be repainted. We have continued to open the hall for church services, funerals and weddings for the use of the toilets.

The time capsule outside under the porch remains untouched.

I wish to thank everyone for their support. While I have been the Chairperson we have received two lottery grants. The cavity walls were filled, a new heating system installed and the kitchen upgraded. Electricity was brought to the cloakrooms which meant that hand dryers and hot water could be installed and later the socket for the Christmas lights and the defibrillator.

We have had some good entertainment in the form of a cinema and a theatre group but as I indicated last year I feel that it is time to give someone else the opportunity to be the Chairperson.
